COMMITTEE	RESPONSIBILITIES
Training Committee	Assist with ITS TX trainings that occur throughout the year including the Summer and Annual meeting trainings. This will include finding the trainers, location for the training, and training day coordination.
Awards Committee	Assist with the review and selection for chapter awards. This includes the ITS Texas Awards for the year (Past President, Project of the Year, etc.).
Student Chapter Committee	Work with student chapters throughout Texas to support their chapters. Members will work directly with each chapter to assist with the Annual Reports, share applications for ITS Texas Student Scholarships, and any other tasks that would support the student chapter. Current chapters include: TSU, UT Arlington, UT Austin, UT Dallas, and UTEP. Includes review of the student scholarships applications. <i>*El Paso Chapter has been filled*</i>

Mr. Le, P.E. PMP, is a Research Engineer and the Dallas Office Program Manager within the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI). He has participated in numerous traffic operations and safety-related research projects. Mr. Le has over 27 years of experience in transportation engineering and planning.

Mr. Le received his BS in Civil Engineering at the University of Minnesota and his MS in Civil Engineering at the University of Arkansas. He worked as a transportation planner/engineer at the Little Rock Metropolitan Planning Organization, Metroplan, before coming to north Texas as a traffic engineer with Jacobs Engineering (formerly Carter & Burgess).

Now as part of TTI's Research & Implementation Division, Mr. Le works closely with TxDOT districts and divisions to deploy the latest cutting-edge research. He works on a variety of projects that cover transportation systems management and operations, intelligent transportation systems, traffic incident management, connected and automated vehicle deployment, integrated corridor management, access management, roadway safety - particularly vulnerable roadway users, and artificial intelligence. He has presented and published his work at multiple conferences and journals.

Mr. Le is currently president of the ITS Texas Board of Directors and a member the Institute of Transportation Engineers. He is also a registered professional engineer (PE) and a project management professional (PMP). He is excited to engage with other industry leaders and professionals to spread ITS awareness and drive innovation for the next generation of technology and workforce.
